Frameworks

To support *Frameworks*, an initiative that provides support for diverse and intergenerational mediamakers who are addressing the compelling issues of their generations. During 2003 and 2004, *Frameworks* supported media artists addressing issues of social justice with direct support, residencies, employment opportunities, mentorships, technical training and exhibition opportunities. *Frameworks* participants engaged in the production of high-quality, cutting-edge progressive media; gained access to state-of-the-art equipment and technical assistance; produced media for other nonprofits; and attended industry-certified workshops. Over the course of the previous two years, filmmakers receiving support from BAVC have produced works that addressed environmental as well as governmental and corporate accountability issues. During the 2005 fiscal year, BAVC will implement artists' residencies for mid and late career mediamakers; provide mediamakers with support, training and access to equipment so that they can complete projects; implement a professional development series that focuses on technology, activism and distribution; and provide 30 youth with an intensive media training experience that enables them to use media to address important issues in their lives and community.
