Honor the Earth's Impacted Nations at NCF

Presidential Authority Grant

To support *Honor the Earth's Impacted Nations* traveling exhibition at the Nathan Cummings Foundation which was created to educate a Native American and American public on the impact and future of energy policy in this country. This exhibition will feature art by Indigenous communities who have been impacted adversely by energy development issues ranging from dam projects and nuclear power plants to coal strip mines and nuclear waste dumps. *Impacted Nations* will feature renewable energy project work that will link together the artwork and the communities. It will also profile both resistance and new visions for the future. The show includes 40 pieces of art from North American Indigenous communities which will be launched at NCF in October of this year. The tentative touring schedule includes venues in Minneapolis, MN; Pine Ridge, SD; Denver, CO; Santa Fe, NM; Helena MT; Seattle, WA; and Portland, OR; all of which have communities that have faced the same circumstances and today are looking toward alternative energy.
