To support Jobs with Justice (JwJ) in its project, Building a Multi-constituency Movement for Healthcare for All: an effort to demonstrate a national presence in the health care reform movement through a coordinated campaign. The long-term goal of JwJ is to create and educate constituencies so that they may work effectively toward health care reform. By building permanent multi-issue coalitions that take on a range of campaigns, leaders and members develop relationships based on trust, democratic processes and power-sharing. JwJ will engage in health care justice campaigns by supporting workers who are organizing and bargaining for better employer-paid health insurance and better working environments. The coalition will also support community fights to strengthen the public safety net through Medicaid, Medicare, and public health care facilities and bring together diverse constituencies to develop and promote pro-active policy proposals that lead to health care for all.
