To support Capacity Building for a Jewish Social Justice Movement: JFREJ, JUFJ, and Tekiah (Capacity for a Movement), a partnership of three locally-based Jewish social justice organizations. Capacity for a Movement will support Jews for Racial and Economic Justice (JFREJ, N.Y.), Jews United For Justice (JUFJ, D.C.), and Tekiah (Boston) to strengthen their work of engaging Jews in meaningful social justice work by building each organization's capacity according to individual needs and stage of development, and in turn, to collectively deepen the national Jewish social justice movement. Through this project, each organization will engage in a strategic planning process; develop their communication and management systems in order to further their membership and outreach goals; and expand their internal capacity through board and staff development. Furthermore, by pursuing the capacity-building process concurrently and in coordination with each other, these three organizations will forge relationships and strengthen the broader Jewish social justice movement nationally.
