*Reboot Summit 2005/Reboot Box/Local Organizing*

**Total Award: \$100,000 over 14 months**

To support Reboot Summit 2005/Reboot Box/Local Organizing in Reboot's ongoing work to bring about a cultural renaissance among young Jews nationwide. Reboot Summit 2005 will convene Reboot's fourth cohort of exceptional and influential young Jews to immerse themselves in their heritage and values, engage in an open examination of their Jewishness and, once engaged, mobilize their peers to do the same. Reboot in a Box, a twice a year multimedia subscription service created by Summit participants, is an effort to bring the Reboot experience of open examination and conversation to a larger number of young Jews around the country. Reboot in a Box will compile contemporary and archival items and send them to subscribers in an effort to trigger conversation and reflection on Jewish heritage and meaning. The Local Organizing element of Reboot's strategy aims to maintain the core network of Reboot participants after the Summit, as well as create new means to build local communities, conversations, networks, and programs inspired by the Reboot Summit. Reboot will strengthen the organizing that occurs locally by developing local Reboot committees, launching a Salon series in Los Angeles and San Francisco, identifying key organizers in New York and San Francisco, and using Reboot products, like the Box, as an active organizing tool.
