Walk the Road to Peace

Presidential Authority Grant

To support Walk the Road to Peace, an interreligious project that integrates national and local action aimed at promoting peace between Israelis and Palestinians. Walk the Road to Peace, through its National Interreligious Leadership Delegation comprised of high level clergy from Protestant, Catholic, Muslim, and Jewish leading institutions, will further develop and express its voice of interreligious cooperation and moral leadership. It will also create a network of local interreligious leadership teams in selected cities across the country to support and advance the vision and educational agenda of the National Delegation. Through meeting with national policy makers and ongoing public education through television, radio, and newspaper pieces, the National Delegation will continue to advocate for US leadership in the peace process and serve as an authoritative voice in the public conversation. The local teams will provide important examples of interreligious cooperation and moral leadership in their communities, while helping to advance the work of the National Delegation and peace process.
