To support Bold Politics, a project whose central goal is to assemble major, transformative reforms to current U.S. governmental policies. These reforms will be based largely on information gathered in the series of polls taken between late 2002 and spring 2004 as part of the tax policy project, and they will be developed in the form of both general narratives and more specific policies. The ideas will be presented to and informed by groups of the public and by national polls. The process will develop themes and policies that resonate strongly with the public. The result will be a coherent, bold, political program of major reform shown to be welcomed by majorities of the American public.
